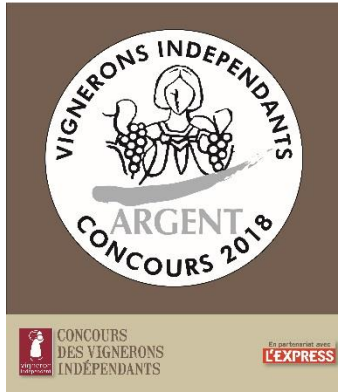


DOMAINE DU

*An old and rare variety still cultivated...*



**Terroir :**

Clay-limestone soils, private valley surrounded by Garrigues forest, manual harvest.

**Designation :**

IGP Pays d'Hérault

**Varietal : 100% Carignan Blanc.**

An old rare grape that produces wines of great finesse with freshness in the mouth. Fiftieth vines.

**Wine making :**

Fermented and Acacia barrel aged for 9 months.

**Wine tasting :**

Pale yellow colour with old gold shades.

Scents of yellow flowers and dried flowers. Lightly buttered flavour. Strong personality underlined by the Acacia ageing.

Creamy, very good persistence. Final on notes of beeswax and ripe fruit.

A hell of a personality, an unexpected pedigree.

**Packaging :**

75cl, Cork caps.

2x3 laid-down bottles in box.
